Competitors must be active members of SSNZ to receive points on the series and are recommended to sign up for this event through the SSNZ website. ## FIS AND WSPL

Athletes who are eligible and currently hold a FIS license may be included in the FIS result. Snowboard athletes on this result will also receive WSPL points. Having a FIS license is not mandatory for this event. New Zealand athletes with a FIS license will automatically be included in the FIS result unless they opt out.
