EVENT DESCRIPTION

This winter the NZ Freestyle National Champs is scheduled over 7 days which includes 2 weather day. This event awards NZ National Titles for skiers & snowboarders under the age of 16 in Ski & Snowboard-cross, Slopestyle, Half Pipe and Big Air. There is also a recreational rail jam. Combined results also (excluding the rail jam) determine the New Zealand Overall National titles, which are presented to each age division at the final awards and afterparty. Included in the Nationals event schedule is FIS (Open age) competitions in Big Air, Slopestyle & Halfpipe disciplines. FIS points are awarded for the ANC disciplines only. FIS points provide international rankings for competitors aiming to compete in World Cup competition and the Olympic Games.

TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETINGS & BIB COLLECTION

Competitors will be able to collect their bibs and lift passes from Friday 26th September from mid-day till 4pm at the Slope-side Guest Services office on the mountain. Competitor bibs will be assigned to athletes for the entire event. The riders briefing will be held at 6pm on Friday 26th September to Cardrona Apres building at 50 Cardrona Valley Road in Wanaka. This briefing will be recorded and uploaded onto the Freestyle Nationals Facebook event page and Snow Sports NZ for everyone to view. Riders who are unable to collect their bibs in advance are encouraged to have someone collect their bibs on their behalf to avoid delays in the morning.

EVENT FORMATS & RULES

Slopestyle: Two judged runs best score counts (straight finals).

SX/SBX: Single run time trial qualifier to seed riders for ¼, Semis or Final rounds. (No race suits!)

Halfpipe: Two judged runs best score counts (straight finals).

Big Air: Two judged runs best score counts (straight finals).

Park Rail Jam: Jam format within each age division

AWARDS: There will be a daily awards presentation held in the Cardrona Courtyard at the conclusion of each event, NZ titles will be awarded to 1st - 3rd in each age division & discipline. Overall NZ Titles will be announced at the After-party scheduled for 6:30pm, Friday 4th October at Apres.

WEATHER POSTPONEMENTS: If an event is postponed, it will move to the postponement day and the dates for the remaining disciplines will remain the same. In the event of multiple postponements an athletes/coaches meeting will be scheduled after the awards to discuss any schedule changes.
