- U14 (born 2011 and younger)
- Open (all ages)

ENTRIES & Lift Passes

- Athletes must pre-register on the Snow Sports NZ website <u>here</u>.
- Entries open: 5-Jul
- Entries close: 16th-Jul, 12pm (late entries may not be accepted)
- Event registration \$50

Lift pass collection is on the morning of the event from Guest Services at Mt Hutt.

- Child (aged 15 and under on the 1st June 2025): \$57.50 per day
- Adult: \$87.50 per day
- Coaches: 1 free coach for every 8 athletes. For teams with less than 8 competitors, lift tickets will be \$87.50 per day.

All competitors must wear bibs appropriately during all scheduled trainings and competition. Bibs will be available to collect from 8.30am at Kea Club 1610 Cafe. We kindly ask for these bibs to be returned after the second run.
