PROGRAM:

Friday 1 September 2023 Race 1 – Super G – Mt Hutt National Youth Championships Race 2 – Super G – Mt Hutt NZL National Points Race

<u>Saturday 2 September 2023</u> 1 x 2 run Race – Giant Slalom – Mt Hutt National Youth Champs

Sunday 3 September 2023 1 x 2 run Race – Slalom – Mt Hutt National Youth Champs

(Please note that all the above races are NZL National Points races. The schedule or order of events may change due to weather or conditions. Final decision will be made at Team Captains meeting.)

ELIGIBILITY:

These races are for the U14, U16 & U19 age groups. Athletes must be registered with Snow Sports NZ as well as having National Points membership.

ENTRY:

Entries and payment must be made online through the Snow Sports NZ website: https://www.snowsports.co.nz/calendar-and-results/2023-events-calendar-and-registration/

ENTRY CLOSES Wednesday 30 August 2023 @ 3pm.

Any entries after this date and time will be considered late entries. Late entries are at the discretion of the Timer and ROC and if accepted will be subject to a \$100 late entry fee per race, in addition to race entry fees, payable immediately.







QUALIFICATION:

The start list will be seeded according to the rules for NZ National Points.

ENTRY FEES:

Super G (National Youth Champs and National Points Race)	\$85.00 / day
Giant Slalom (National Youth Champs)	\$75.00 / day
Slalom (National Youth Champs)	\$65.00 / day

ATHLETE AND COACH LIFT PASSES:

- \$49.50 Child (6-15 years)
- \$79.50 (for youth athletes 16 years +)

Discounted lift price is for competitors only. Coaches are entitled to a FOC lift pass for every 8 competitors entered. Coaches with less than 8 competitors receive 50% off single day lift pass rate (50% of \$159.00). Additional coaches are also entitled to discounted lift passes as above. Coaches must be a coach of a program recognised by SSNZ and NZ Ski.

If a race or races are postponed or cancelled on a scheduled race date the discount is no longer available and all lift passes will be full price.

Please note that payment must be made in full before any lift passes can be issued and uplifted from Guest Services. Please see https://www.mthutt.co.nz/Terms-Conditions/ for lift pass terms and conditions. Prior to the start of the TCM, you will be able to purchase lift passes from the Mt Hutt town office at 84 Main Street, through until 5pm. If you are unable to get your lift passes at that location prior to 5pm, you will also be able to purchase lift passes from Guest Services on the mountain and they will be open from 8am in the morning. There will be no pass purchase at Team Captains meeting. Pre-organising passes is highly recommended.







Lifts open at 9am for competitors. (If First Tracks is open then the lift opens at 8am if you have a First Tracks pass. The rates above do not give you access to First Tracks).

It is the responsibility of the relevant club and coaches to make certain that all participants attending the races are of an appropriate standard relevant to the racing to be undertaken.
