Each race day will be 2 x single run races; separate results for each run.

The schedule or order of events may change due to weather or conditions. This may be announced as late as the morning of the event on the mountain, so athletes need to have both disciplines equipment prepared and available at the mountain.

Eligibility

Open to Snow Sport New Zealand (SSNZ) registered athletes: U8, U10, U12, U14 & U16.

Please note all athletes must be SSNZ registered, and speed suits are not required.

Entry Fees \$40.00/athlete/race day

Registration Entries close on Wednesday 6 September 2023 @ 3pm.

Lift tickets

- \$49.50 Child (6-15 years)
- \$79.50 (for youth athletes 16 yrs +)
- Under 5 years old receives a free lift ticket

Discounted lift price is for competitors only. Coaches are entitled to a FOC lift pass for every 8 competitors entered. Coaches with less than 8 competitors receive 50% off single day lift pass rate (50% of \$159.00). Additional coaches are also entitled to discounted lift passes as above. Coaches must be a coach of a program recognised by SSNZ and NZ Ski.

Lifts open at 9am for competitors.

(If First Tracks is open then the lift opens at 8am if you have a First Tracks pass. The rates above do not give you access to First Tracks.)
