#### **About Coronet Peak**

The FIS Australia New Zealand Cup events will take place at Coronet Peak which is a world class ski resort with extraordinary views of Queenstown and the Wakatipu Basin. Coronet Peak is home to some of the most diverse terrain in the Southern Lakes.

The Giant Slalom course extends the length of the mountain running from the top of the Hurdle to the Rocky Gully T-Bar. The Slalom is held on Race Arena which is located on the skiers left side of the Rocky Gully T-Bar and is noted for its pitch and undulating terrain.

#### **Entries**

Entries must be completed using the <u>official FIS Form</u> and submitted to <u>hannah@wintergamesnz.kiwi</u> by the deadline of 20 August 2024 at 5pm.

Giant Slalom - \$100, Slalom - \$90. Payment must be made prior to the first TCM via the online link sent to you by <a href="mailto:race@coronetpeak.co.nz">race@coronetpeak.co.nz</a> on confirmation of entries.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

A 100% refund of entry fees and unused lift tickets is offered if we call off the race the day prior or we are unable to start the race. Refunds will only be given for payments made by credit card.

#### **Bibs**

Bibs will be allocated at the Team Captain's Meetings. A bib deposit of \$100 per team or \$20 per individual will be required by credit card at the first TCM. The bib deposit will be refunded once the entire team has returned their bibs.

#### **Lift Tickets**

Upon the receival of an email confirmation of entry, directions will be sent on how to pay for entries and lift tickets online. Lift ticket purchases online are for athletes only. All athlete passes are 50% discount from a full day pass. One free coach pass is offered per six athletes. Extra coach passes are available at athlete prices.

Do not use the link to purchase coach and official passes, rather please email <a href="mailto:race@coronetpeak.co.nz">race@coronetpeak.co.nz</a> the names, birth date and contact (email or number) of the coaches so we can preprint passes to be picked up at Guest Services. You will then be responsible to pay for the passes the day prior to the race.






# **Team Captains Meetings**

# **Liability & Insurance**

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event do so at their own risk. Winter Games NZ sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers will not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by athletes, officials or other people in conjunction with the organising or staging of the event. Public Liability Insurance of CHF 3 million is in place for the period of the event.

If you are injured in New Zealand (including while competing), you may need the assistance of the Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC) which helps to pay for your care your treatment and recovery while you are in New Zealand. ACC will not cover any medical or related costs after you leave New Zealand therefore you still need to arrange your own travel and medical insurance. Surcharges will apply in most New Zealand medical facilities for visitors.

















#### **Visas**

New Zealand has a special policy for athletes, coaches, administrators, officials and support staff visiting the country to participate in sporting events. Please check with Immigration NZ to **find** out if visitors from your country require a visitor visa to enter New Zealand. Information and application forms for visitor visas are available on <a href="www.immigration.govt.nz">www.immigration.govt.nz</a> or from New Zealand and Australian Consulates, Embassies or High commissions.

## Travel, Logistics & Accommodation

**Air Travel** - We recommend that you book your flights as early as possible and fly into Queenstown or Christchurch depending on your travel plans. Air New Zealand, Jetstar, Qantas and Virgin Australia are the only airlines flying directly into Queenstown. However, many others come into Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch and connect to other domestic services.

**Vehicle Transport** – There are many rental car agencies based in and around the airport. Look for listings on <u>Touchdown Luxury Car Rental</u> (our event partner), <u>SIXT Car Rental</u>, <u>Avis Car Rental</u>, <u>Budget Car Rental</u>.

A public bus service connects most areas of the Wakatipu Basin. The timetable can be found here Queenstown buses (orc.govt.nz)

A ski bus to Coronet Peak runs throughout the day from The Station Building in Queenstown. The bus also stops several times enroute including at Creekside and Arthur's Point. The bus is \$20pp return Queenstown Ski Bus | Coronet Peak
