EVENT DESCRIPTION

On behalf of the organizing committee, we are pleased to invite eligible athletes to The Remarkables where we will be hosting the FIS ANC Slopestyle competition.

The training and competition for the ANC Slopestyle will take place on the 17th of August 2024, with a weather day scheduled for the 18th of August.

Event podiums will be awarded and FIS registered athletes are eligible for FIS results and points towards the 2024 FIS ANC series.

ENTRIES

All athletes participating in the FIS ANC must have a valid FIS license issued under the authority of their national ski association.

Australia and New Zealand may enter up to 40 men and 20 women in each competition organised in the other nation. Maximum 10 (total women and men / maximum 8 per gender). The Organiser has discretion to accept additional athletes above the quota.

Please make sure that all athletes have a valid FIS license.

The ANC rules are available on the FIS website.

NSAs must complete a FIS Entry Form and send it to sami@snowsports.co.nz.

Final entries deadline: Aug 3rd, 2024

After submitting the final entry, athletes <u>must register online</u> and pay the entry fees by **Aug 10**th, **2024.**

Entries are not guaranteed if entry fees are not paid. Event registration - \$50







LIFT PASSES

To be collected on the morning of the event from Guest Services at The Remarkables. <u>Competitor (50% discount):</u>

- Child (aged 15 and under on the 1st June 2024): \$52.50 per day
- Adult: \$82.50 per day

<u>Coaches</u> – 1 free coach to 8 athletes. For teams with less than 8 competitors, lift tickets will be \$82.50 per day (50% discount).

All competitors must wear bibs appropriately during all scheduled trainings and competition. Bibs will be available to collect from 7.45am at Guest Services at The Remarkables. We kindly ask for these bibs to be returned.

WEATHER POSTPONEMENTS

The weather day is scheduled for the 18th of August. There is one weather day scheduled for the FIS ANC. If an event is postponed, it will move to the postponement day.

MEDICAL PROCUDURE

For all official training and competition days, there will be dedicated medical staff at the top of the course, provided by The Remarkables who can respond on the course if needed.

There is a medical centre up at The Remarkables that will advise the next step if need be. Please follow medical staff directions at all times, even if you have your own medical team.
